Five years ago a house situated on a lot adjacent to Ministry and More Inc. was vacated, and has been vacant ever since as the property went through foreclosure. Although Ministry and More Inc. inquired about the property at that time and since, it was tied up in legal proceedings that went on and on. Recently, over the course of a



few weeks, new information about the property became available and upon follow up, it was learned the property would soon become available to be bid on. Through amazing circumstances (that mysteriously look like God's hand at work) the realtor from Champaign, in charge of listing the property (who 'happened' to be a Christian) responded to our attempt to contact him, dropped by our pantry in person to check us out, and gave us hope that acquisition of the property might be possible. We have been prayerfully excited over the possibility of securing the property for future use, and to ensure that the area around the

pantry remains a safe, and well maintained face to the neighborhood.



Our bid on the house has just been accepted and we hope to be closing on the purchase of this property by the end of November!
